In order to provide a welcoming and enjoyable environment for everyone, we ask that all members and guests abide by the following club rules. Failure to do so can result in loss of club membership.

Please keep the club tidy

Make sure to leave the place as you found it - or better! Trashcans are available throughout the property. Cookouts are encouraged, just make sure no evidence is left behind.

Abide by clubhouse hours

The clubhouse is open for members to use on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays from 9AM-6PM. BYOB for now. Enjoy the WiFi, the AC, the setting, and the roofdeck. Parts of the clubhouse may not be available at times because of special events. The clubhouse is not open during the week, but the bathrooms are always accessible through the back door.

Honor systems

For now many of our amenities may be provided on an honor system - things like ice, guest fees, etc. Please respect the honor system and pay as applicable.

No shoes, no shirt, usually no problem

Just be sure to cover up enough to stay safe - there are plenty of dangers like bugs, sun, and rocks around so dress accordingly.

Pet policy

Well-behaved dogs are allowed on the property provided they're kept on a leash at all times. Be sure to clean up after your dog. Dogs are not allowed within the pool gate. Like their humans, dogs may be asked to leave if their behavior is disturbing the peace.

Children policy

Children must be under the supervision of an adult or competent youth at all times.

Swimming

The pool is open for anyone who has a pool membership or guest pass, from sunrise to sunset everyday. Please abide by the pool rules at all times. Swimming in the river directly around the marina is prohibited.

Docks

Club members have use of the boat launch and floating dock. Please be mindful of others that need to use them as well, and launch boats quickly and efficiently at both locations. The three marina piers are for slipholders only, and unless invited as a guest of slipholder, they are off limits to others for safety reasons.

Boat Rentals

Boat rentals are available through the adjacent marina, The Slips. Taking out any of these boats must be arranged through The Slips and all of their rules and regulations are to be followed.

Please keep the pool tidy

Make sure to leave the place as you found it - or better! Trashcans are available at the pool. Any pool toys, towels, etc. left behind likely won't survive.

Absolutely no glass

No glass containers of any sort are allowed within the pool gates.

No loud, drunken, or disorderly conduct

We like to keep it family friendly around here and reserve the right to remove anyone that we feel is disturbing the peace. Playing children and playing music are encouraged, just make sure it stays mellow enough to not infringe on the poolside enjoyment of others around.

Pet policy

Dogs and pets of any sort are not allowed within the pool gate.

Children policy

Children must be accompanied at all times by a competent adult. No child under the age of 12 may be at the pool without an adult.

Don't you dare dive

Absolutely no diving, these are shallow waters!

Don't run about either

Far too many tripping hazards here.

No lifeguard on duty

All pool members and guests understand that there is no lifeguard on duty and all swimming is done at your own risk. Please take all necessary safety precautions while in and around the pool.
